SUMMARY OF THE CALL IN ENGLISH

Foreword

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR NON-EU CITIZENS NON-RESIDENT IN ITALY TO THE FIRST YEAR OF THE ONE-CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY WITH LIMITED ACCESS (Class LM-41) IN ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY

Admittance to the Degree Course is subject to selection through the University's admissions procedure.

Art. 1 Number of places available

This call is intended for **3 available places for Non-EU students. Candidates of this call will be automatically considered also for the reserve list in case more places become available** due the withdrawal of non-EU students already enrolled.

The number of places available may change in accordance with a later Decree of the Ministry of Education, University and Research (M.I.U.R.), pursuant to the provisions of Law n. 264, August 2, 1999. The Decree of MIUR could confirm, increase or decrease the number of places available.

Art. 2 Admission requirements

The following candidates are *NOT entitled to apply* for the present call of applications on penalty of exclusion:

- Citizens of Italy, including those candidates holding a double Citizenship (i.e. Citizens holding Italian citizenship together with a citizenship of a another country).
- The citizens of United Kingdom, the Republic of San Marino, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Switzerland.
- Non-EU citizens holding a residence permit in Italy for employment or self-employment, for family reasons, political asylum or asylum for humanitarian or religious reasons.
- Non-EU citizens legally resident in Italy from at least one year in possession of a Secondary School Diploma obtained in Italy.
- Refugees.

- Diplomatic personnel accredited to International Organizations in Italy, the Italian Republic, the Vatican City State and their dependants.

Applicants who do not meet the citizenship requirements will not be included in the ranking.

To apply, candidates must obtain a Secondary School Diploma within the month of July 2017.

Candidates are also required to meet School qualification requirements specified Annex A on penalty of exclusion.

In order to enrol for the first year of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery, a secondary school diploma is considered valid if obtained after at least 12 years of education, accompanied by the Declaration of Value issued by the Italian diplomatic authorities.

In the event that the local school system provides for 11 or 10 years of schooling, the title is valid when integrated with one or two years of university, having passed all the required exams for those academic years.

Candidates not holding valid qualification will, according to the requirements of law, lose the right to enrol. Further, if already enrolled, the candidate's enrolment will be cancelled.

Art. 3 Admissions

Admissions will be granted based on the UKCAT test. UKCAT test is a computer-based multiple choice test. Question mix is reported in Article 5.

Only the following UKCAT tests score are considered valid for admissions:

- 2016 standard UKCAT test held from July to October 2016;
- Special Humanitas University UKCAT test held from April 18th to April 26th 2017

Standard UKCAT tests sat in 2017 and before 2016 will not be considered valid for the admission.

Candidates will be included in the ranking on the basis of the UKCAT score achieved.

Candidates must complete Humanitas University Application Form at the following link: <https://www.hunimed.eu/application-form/> and pay a fee of 50 € by credit card. Application and payment of the fee must be performed from **July 10th, 2017** until **August 25th, 2017** on penalty of exclusion.

During the application procedure, candidates are required to:

- Specify their UKCAT ID;

- Specify the total UKCAT score reported on July-October 2016 UKCAT or 2017 Special Humanitas University UKCAT (verbal reasoning + quantitative reasoning + abstract reasoning);
- Specify the band achieved in the Situational Judgement (SJT);
- Pay the fee of 50 € by credit card through the PayPal System.

Art. 4 Procedure for the study visa

Important: Student who wish to register this call must contact the local embassy or consulate in order to verify, for each country of origin, whether they are still entitled to start the procedure to receive the study VISA.

Humanitas University will not be responsible for any VISA denial which for any reasons might occur.

Art. 5 Contents of the test

Questions mix of UKCAT tests considered for this call is reported below:

Subtest	Time	Number of Questions*	min score	Top score
Verbal Reasoning	22 minutes	44	300	900
Quantitative Reasoning	25 minutes	36	300	900
Abstract Reasoning	14 minutes	55	300	900
Total (Verbal, Quantitative, Abstract).	61 minutes	135	900	2700

* each UKCAT subtest includes one minute of instruction.

Candidates will be admitted on the basis of the ranking generated in descending order according to the score achieved.

For each subtest scores are as follows:

- from 300 points to 900 points on the basis of the correct answers provided to Verbal Reasoning subtest
- from 300 points to 900 points on the basis of the correct answers provided to Quantitative Reasoning subtest

- from 300 points to 900 points on the basis of the correct answers provided to Abstract Reasoning subtest

The highest achievable score is 2700 points.

In case of a draw, the following criteria are applied:

- a) The points scored by the candidates respectively in the Verbal Reasoning subtest, Quantitative Reasoning subtest, Abstract reasoning subtest, respectively, will prevail in descending order.
- b) In case of further draw, the youngest student will prevail.

Art. 6 – Publication of the ranking list

The ranking will be published by Humanitas University **on August 30th, 2017** on the website www.hunimed.eu, maintaining anonymity. Candidates will be able to see their position in the ranking through the pre-matriculation number generated during the Admissions Test application procedure. Moreover, using the *username* and *password* obtained during the registration on the portal, candidates can see their score by accessing their personal page.

Art. 7 – Online enrolment and reserve list

Admitted candidates according to the ranking must enrol online. Online enrolment will be possible between **August 30th to September 6th**. **The first instalment in the amount of € 4.156 must be paid mandatorily by September 6th, 2017 on penalty of exclusion. The first instalment of 4.156 € shall in no case be reimbursed. From September 7th, the enrolment from reserve list will begin.**

Should admitted candidates decide not to enrol to Humanitas University, an e-mail can be sent to info@hunimed.eu in order to communicate the candidate's decision.

Not covered places will be filled according to the following procedure:

- Publication on the website www.hunimed.eu of the number of places not covered due to withdrawals. Based on the test ranking, the University will begin the admission of those candidates whose position in test ranking was beyond the number of admissions places available (reserve list).
- Eligible candidates must enrol and pay the first instalment within two working days from the day of publication of each reserve list by 6.00 p.m. of the second day.
- The procedure will be iterated until there are no more places available.

Candidates who do not comply with the above-mentioned deadlines will lose the right to enrol at Humanitas University.

Art.8 – Completion of enrolment at Humanitas University

Candidates who have completed the online enrolment procedure must complete the enrolment procedure by bringing to the Student Office the following documents:

- a) Enrolment Form signed by the student (downloaded from MyPORTAL after online enrolment has been completed);
- b) Photocopy of the payment receipt of the first instalment;
- c) Photocopy of Passport;
- d) Photocopy of tax code (Codice Fiscale);
- e) Permit of Stay (Permesso di Soggiorno) as soon as it is granted;
- f) For students holding a foreign secondary school certificate, a copy of that certificate translated into Italian and legalized by the Italian Consulate/Cultural Institutes, together with the Dichiarazione di Valore (Declaration of Value) released by the Consulate.

The above-mentioned documents can be handed in at Humanitas University Student Office from Monday to Friday, from 9.00 to 13.00 and from 14.00 to 17.00. An appointment is not necessary.

Once enrolled at Humanitas University, students from other universities can submit their curriculum and request the transfer of credits, which is subject to evaluation according to the Humanitas University procedure.

Country Qualification	Minimum entry-Requirements
International Baccalaureate	12 Years of School Education: IB score of 36 is accepted. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 6 (out of 7) or above of at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
UK qualification with A levels	12 Years of School Education: student with an UK high school qualification are required to achieve 3 A levels in medicine and science related subject with a minimum grade of B.
Australia	12 Years of School Education: ATAR score of 80 in addition to a pass in the Year 12 High School Certificate of Education. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Argentina	12 Year of School Education: Título de Bachiller is accepted with a minimum score of Sobresaliente (9-10/10). Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Brasil	12 Years of School Education: The Brazilian Certificato de Ensino Medio is accepted with a minimum score of (9/10) (Excelente, Superior). Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Canada	12 Years of School Education: Achieve 80% overall average among different subjects. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology
China	12 Years of School Education: National Senior High School Certificate (three years), is accepted with an overall Grade B (80%). Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Egypt	12 Year of School Education: General Secondary School Certificate (Thanaweya A'ama) or Al Azhar, General Secondary School Certificate, is accepted with at least A 90% (out of 100%) overall. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Iran	12 Years of School Education: The Pre-University Certificate (Peeshdanehgahe) is accepted with an overall score of at least 16 out of 20. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.

Country	Minimum entry-Requirements
India	12 Years of School Education. The Indian High School Leaving Certificate (CBSE and ISC boards only) at the end of standard XII is accepted with an overall average score of 80%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Israel	12 Years of High School Education. The Bagrut (Matriculation) is accepted with an overall average score of 80%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Iraq	12 Years of School Education. Certificate of Preparatory Education or Secondary School Certificate is accepted with an overall average score of 90%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Lebanon	12 Years of School Certificate. Lebanese Baccalaureate, is accepted with an overall average score of 16 out 20 overall. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Ghana	12 Years of High School Certificate. West African Examination Certificate is accepted with an average of 90% (out of 100%) A1 and 80%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Hong Kong	12 Years of School Education: Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) is accepted with an average of 4 out of 5. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Malaysia	12 Years of School Education: the STPM and the United Examination Certificate (UEC) are accepted with a minimum of A2. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Nigeria	12 Years of High School Certificate. West African Examination Certificate is accepted with an average of 90% (out of 100%) A1. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Pakistan	12 Years of School Education: A-levels in 3 Medicine and science subject or International Baccalaureate.

Country	Minimum entry-Requirements
Russia	12 Years of School Education: Attestat, is accepted with a minimum Grade of 4.0 out of 5.0 overall.
Saudi Arabia	12 Years of School Education: General Secondary Certificate (Al Thanawiya Al Aama) is accepted with an average of 90% (out of 100%) A1. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Singapore	12 Years of School Education: Singapore A-levels in 3 Medicine or science related subject are acceptable..
South Africa	12 Years of School Education: The National Senior Certificate is accepted with grades of 6 (out of 7). Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
South Korea	12 Years of School Education: Inmungye KodBng High School Diploma, is accepted with a minimum overall average of 80%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Taiwan	12 Year of School Education: Senior High School Leaving Certificate, is accepted with an overall average grade of 80%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Thailand	12 Years of School Education: Mathayom 6 (M6) is accepted with a GPA 3.2 out of 4. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Turkey	12 Years of School Education: Lise Diplomasi, is accepted with an overall average grade of 80%. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
USA	12 Years of School Certificate Students with US high school qualifications are required to achieve 3 Advance Placement in Medicine and Science related subjects.
Venezuela	12 Years of School Education: Venezuelan Senior High School Certificate is accepted, achieving an average overall average grade of 16 out of 20. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.

Country	Minimum entry-Requirements
Vietnam	12 Years of School Education achieving an overall GPA of 8.0, (out of 10.0). Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
Other High School Qualifications	12 Years of School Education is accepted with an overall 80% in GPA grades. Furthermore in the last year of high school grades should be 80% or above of the highest grading scale score at least in two subjects among math, physics, chemistry and biology.
