



The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is the world's most popular English language test, recognised by more than 11,000 organisations worldwide and by leading European universities.

The IELTS test is an international passport for anyone who wants to certify their ability to study and work in an English-speaking environment. It is required to apply for study programs or short study periods abroad.

□ The IELTS certificate does not expire, but we recommend checking the requirements of the institution you are applying to.

The three main IELTS tests available are: Academic, General and UKVI:

- Take IELTS Academic if you want to study at an undergraduate or postgraduate level in an English-speaking country;
- Take IELTS General Training if you want to Work or undertake work-related training in an English-speaking country;
- Take IELTS for UKVI If you are taking the IELTS test to support a UK visa application to study, work, or live in the UK, Australia, Canada and New Zealand.

Depending on your preference, you can now take your IELTS test either on paper or on a computer at one of the official test centres in Italy. IELTS on computer is exactly the same test as IELTS on paper

in terms of content and structure, but instead of writing your answers on paper, you will type them on a computer.

With IELTS on computer, you will now have more test dates and sessions to choose from - and your results will be available in 3-5 days.
